

GINSENG & ZIZYPHUS FORMULA

Clinical Presentation

Chronic urticaria, heart disease, neurasthenia, insomnia, apthous ulcers, and menopausal syndrome.

Symptom Presentation

Low grade fever, **insomnia with restless sleep**, **night sweat**, fatigue, sores on mouth or tongue, **palpitations**, dry stools, **anxiety**, irritability, **forgetfulness**, **inability to think or concentrate**, and nocturnal emissions.

Tongue

Red tongue with little coat.

Pulse

Fine, rapid pulse.

Energetic Functions

Supplements the yin, nourishes the blood, supplements the heart, quiets the spirit.

Chinese Medical Indications

Yin vacuity of heart and kidneys.

Raw Rehmannia supplements the yin, nourishes the blood and clears heat. It enriches the kidney yin to treat vacuity-fire flaming upwards. Salvia and Dong Quai root supplement and quicken the blood to nourish the heart without causing stasis. Biota seed, Zizyphus seed and Polygala quiet the spirit. Kirin Ginseng and Poria boost the qi. Asparagus tuber, Ophiopogon and Scrophularia enrich the yin and clear vacuity fire. Schisandra secures essence. Platycodon guides the actions of the other medicinals to the upper burner.

Formula Differentiation

Ginseng & Zizyphus Formula and Ginseng & Longan Formula are both used to treat insomnia, palpitations and forgetfulness. Ginseng & Zizyphus Formula is indicated for a heart and kidney yin vacuity with restlessness, anxiety, night sweat and a red tongue with little coat and rapid, thready pulse.

Ginseng & Longan Formula is indicated for insomnia, palpitations and forgetfulness with a dual qi and blood vacuity and spleen and heart vacuity with a reduced appetite, a pale tongue, and a thready, frail pulse. Palpitations with debility due to vacuity of qi and blood are treated by Ginseng Nutritive Formula. These latter two formulas do not treat the yin vacuity for which Ginseng & Zizyphus Formula is indicated. Palpitations from replete blood stasis are treated by Blood Mansion Formula. Palpitations due to blood stasis with qi stagnation and blood vacuity are treated by Salvia Plus Formula. Bupleurum & Dragon Bone Formula is indicated for chest fullness, agitation and irritablity with occasional palpitations due to a pathogen lodged in the interior. The latter three formulas are not indicated for the vacuity symptom of insomnia.

Both Ginseng & Zizyphus Formula and Zizyphus Formula treat insomnia and irritability. Ginseng & Zizyphus Formula is for insomnia due to yin vacuity of the heart and kidney. The kidney (water) controls the heart (fire). In kidney yin vacuity, the yin vacuity fire flames upwards and vexes the heart spirit. This is characterized by a patient who is able to lie down, but experiences insomnia with very restless sleep including the restless movement of limbs, and an inability to think or concentrate for even short periods of time.

The focus of **Zizyphus Formula** is on treating insomnia and irritability due to the failure of liver blood to nourish the heart. This insomnia is characterized by a patient who is able to lie down, but experiences insomnia while the mind remains clear. Since liver blood is a yin substance, there may be yin vacuity signs, such as night sweat, but the liver blood vacuity symptoms of dizziness and vertigo, as well as emotional upset are more prominent.

Anem-Phello & Rehmannia Formula, Ginseng & Zizyphus Formula and Two Immortals Formula all treat menopausal syndrome. Anem-Phello & Rehmannia Formula is indicated for kidney yin vacuity with vacuity fire. This would be characterized by tidal fever, malar flush, hot flashes, night sweat, along with insomnia. Two Immortals Formula is indicated for dual vacuity of kidney yin and yang, with vacuity fire. This includes the symptoms of the previous formula plus the addition of cold from yang vacuity, sometimes characterized simply by cold feet.

Ginseng & Zizyphus Formula is for menopausal syndrome where yin vacuity signs present as heart and kidney symptoms characterized by night sweat with prominent restless insomnia, anxiety, irritability, forgetfulness, and an inability to concentrate.

Cautions and Contraindications

The classic formula calls for the addition of Cinnabaris (*zhu sha*), a toxic substance. This ingredient is not included in the Chinese Classics formulation.
